The second week of August we were honored to have Roseburg Alliance (RAC) return for another great week. They partnered with the Angels for a Children's ministry at a ranch for migrant children. The Angels led the teaching while RAC provided encouragement, a craft each day, and a snack for everyone attending. Tuesday morning the team partnered with the Angels for a prayer walk on the streets of San Vicente. On the prayer walk they went door to door asking people if they could pray for them. Each time we do this they get a wide variety of responses from "no, why would you do that" to "please, I need prayer".

The team raised extra funds and built a house for a church family. The church leaders chose who is worthy of a house and the family must buy the land, and with the church, prepare the building site including the floor. Our team then comes in and builds the walls and puts on a roof. We also do the electrical wiring, insulation and sheetrock. It is then up to the family to finish the house as they choose.

For Lynne and myself it is always exciting to see how God will use the team, the Angels and the local church to change the lives of everyone involved.

Pastor Ricky did an awesome job leading the team and Doug Bentley did amazing in raising the funds for the project.

While traveling the west coast to share about the ministry in San Vicente we have had to make some changes to our plans. Early September Dave was admitted into the hospital for extremely high blood pressure and heart rate. He was diagnosed with "Atrial Fibrillation. Due to this problem we have moved into a 5th Wheel, on loan from Dave's brother, in Salem, Oregon. At the advise of the doctors it appears we will be calling this home until after Christmas.

Mexican Medical has graciously given us the time needed to allow the medical professionals to correct and stabilize Dave's problems. It is our desire and that of the mission to return to serve several more years in Mexico.
