126 Adults Prayed to Receive Christ



In March, Mexican Medical Ministries brought the medical outreach that we call a "Brigada" to Tecate. It was an awesome day! There were 85 volunteers from the U.S. who joined with over 200 volunteers from Tijuana and Tecate that came from 17 different churches. Together they worked as

one body and at the end of the day this group of volunteers gave out 798 services (8 legal counsel, 106 haircuts, 196 medical and 183 dental consults, 264 eye glasses, and 41 foot care). Before each person left the Brigada they heard the Gospel presented in several ways. As a result there were 126 adults who prayed to receive Christ for the first time.

Since that time he has been taking classes and he agreed to preach even though he was very nervous about preaching. Then he remembered some of the things that he had learned in my class about preparing for a message and it helped him get started. When he gave an invitation one 16 year old young man came forward. He had been rebelling against his father but that morning he wanted to give his life to Jesus. But this wasn't just one of the youth of the church, this was Omar's son. ¡Gloria a Dios!
