Making a difference in the Lives of Students

It has been a joy teaching here, in Mexico for these past many years. It's a joy to go to local churches and meet Pastors and other church leaders and see their excitement in studying the Bible. This is one of the reasons we are here in Mexico...to equip others to effectively teach people the Bible.

One of these churches is the Iglesia Del Nazareno de San Vicente (Nazarene Church in San Vicente). Over the past few years of teaching in San Vicente the church has encouraged their people to attend these classes, as well as other seminars sponsored by the church. Many have attended and this training is one of the things that has helped the church mature in many areas. The church has many ministries to the community, such as feeding programs, ministering in migrant camps and health education in local schools.



This church also takes a group of people, each year, on mission trips to various parts of Baja and mainland Mexico.

Also, there have been a number of members from the church who have gone to Bible College. One of those members is Juanito

Hernandez, who happens to have been in my classes.

Recently, he enrolled in a Bible College, close to where we live, full time. I received a note from



him that was a joy and encouragement. He said that it was because of the classes he took from me, and the way I taught, is what God used to call him to serve Him. He said his goal is to teach the Bible

full time. This is the impact that I desire to see in my students... to see them desire to be prepared to teach God's Word to others.

I will be going back to Iglesia Del Nazareno in San Vicente June 8 – 13 to teach the second half of the book of Psalms. Also, that week, I will be teaching at the Templo Elim Iglesia Old Testament survey. *Pray for these classes and the people who will be in these classes.*
