At our last report we reported about the "Ablation" to my heart. Well a few days later my heart returned to the AFIB condition which resulted in a new medication and they shocked my heart to reset the rhythm. That corrected the AFIB but then it began skipping beats. The skipping beats made it very difficult to do much as I would encounter dizzy and lightheaded feelings whenever I tried to do much. The doctor suggested to give it 6 weeks to see if my heart would correct itself.

Slowly I begin to feel better and that allowed me to begin light exercise. After 7 weeks I was doing much better.

The next visit to the Cardiologist he said I was good to go. Both the AFIB and the heart skipping beats had been controlled. He said he would see me in 6 months and we were free to return to Mexico and resume full time ministry to the town and people we have grown to love.

Immediately we begin the process of packing up, returning the 5th wheel (Dave's brother has so generously loaned to us), saying our good byes and leaving. On the way south we were able to see some family which was very special.

We are now back in San Vicente and have a full summer schedule planned. Thank you for your prayers, encouragement and support during the past several
