We will be partnering with our MMM missionaries, Dr. Alvaro and Soledad Avila, with our main focus to repair, improve and finish projects at their clinic, Clínica Aqua Viva. Some of the planned projects are building a retaining wall, painting, repairing fencing and more. Along with home visits and medical outreaches, Dr. Alvaro utilizes this 2 room clinic for consults and extended care to those in need. In the evenings, we will also have opportunities to assist the local churches with their ongoing ministries and outreaches to reach the communities in Cabo for Christ. We will take volunteers with all abilities and skills. You will need a passport book and a willing heart to serve.

Participation fee: includes ground transportation in Mexico, travel insurance, meals, housing, t-shirt, and materials for ministry. (Note: this fee does not include airfare to SJD)

Application and deposit of \$250 is due by **April 1, 2018** and balance of \$350.00 is due by **May 1, 2018**.

Flight Arrangements (not included in participation fee): All team members will purchase their own ticket, arriving at the airport outside of Cabo San Luis-San Jose del Cabo (SJD). For the 8 day team volunteers need to book their flight to arrive between 3:00 – 5:30 pm on Saturday June 2 and departure flights from SJD should be around noon on June 9. Flights usually cost between \$300-\$500 (depending on where you fly from). Early bookings are better prices. For the shorter and longer teams we will talk to you about best flights to book.

Housing: Local hotel (2 people per room)

Food: Healthy/safe food along with purified water will be provided.

Health Warning: According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention this is a Flavivirus area, which is carried by mosquitos and human contact. This includes Zika, Dengue Fever and Chikungunya. No pregnant women can participate in this trip. We will send more information on how to prevent mosquito bites and will take every precaution possible.
