Diabetes is rampant in Mexico — that being the case, holding 'Information Classes on Diabetes' is a wonderful way for the evangelical churches to reach out to the people around them with the love of Jesus and the message of salvation. We held our first two classes this month, and had 23 people show up to the first class and 18 people come to the second. The information given was very helpful we were told, and we know that several people since are trying to make changes in their lives. For example: the pastor's wife was horrified to learn that the use of Splenda wasn't any different to our bodies than using sugar. So she's stopped using Splenda, and now uses Stevia; and she is now walking for a half hour every day. Hallelujah! She was the kind of woman who expected everyone to wait on her and was very unhappy when they didn't. Now she's up and walking. She is a neat lady. We hope these small clinics will be very helpful to the people here. Susan Mix, a Nurse Practitioner from Oregon was the teacher, and she will be returning in October for our next classes.

This month we were invited to speak to a leadership group from Loreto Bay, (the largest group of foreign homeowners in Loreto), about ins and outs of the medical system here in Loreto, and how people can access emergency care. It was followed up by a Seminar put on by Sharp Global Patient Services from San Diego, some local Doctors and one from La Paz, to help foreigners understand what to do in an emergency. It was a wonderful seminar, very helpful, and we were glad to be called upon to help as well.


