Job purpose

The Home Office Missionary (HOM) will work on behalf of our Field Missionaries Northern and Southern Baja California, Mexico. This individual will be in charge of processing donated inventory and help facilitate delivery of materials to field missionaries. They will also assist field missionaries with transportation needs of short term mission teams to designated sites. This position is for a full-time missionary with MMM and will need to raise their own support through churches and individuals willing to assist in this special work. Based out of Lemon Grove, CA with frequent trips and stays in Mexico.

Duties and responsibilities

Warehouse: Build relationships with local donors, corporations and U. S. churches. Convey current needs of our field missionaries with others. Count and inventory supplies that come into the warehouse. Prepare receipt letters for donors. Maintain an orderly and neat warehouse.

Field Missionary needs: Communicate with field missionaries to determine materials needed for outreaches and team ministry. Assist in transporting materials and helping to guide short-term mission teams to sites.

Driver: Assist in Mission Trip/Volunteer Facilitation: Assist groups and individuals in the field to ensure a meaningful and impactful mission trip experience.

Mission Team/Volunteer Interaction: Help lead Bible devotions, orientation and cultural information as needed. Follow up with team leaders and other key participants after trip as called upon.

Required Qualifications

- Able to demonstrate excellent leadership, team management and organizational skills
- Ability to serve, lead, work and interact with people in a positive manner
- One year Bible college or Bible education classes
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills for both internal and external uses

- Have and maintain a current passport
- Construction skills a plus
- Proficiency in conversational Spanish or willingness to pursue language requirements

All missionaries with Mexican Medical Ministries will demonstrate these general abilities:

- **Spiritual Maturity:** Mature follower of Christ who supports missional culture and spiritual vision of MMM. Maintain God-ordained priorities in your life by putting Jesus Christ first. Maintain an active involvement in a local church.

All missionaries are faith supported and will raise necessary personal funds before leaving for the field.

- **Goal Settings:** Actively participates in setting team goals; is forward thinking in creating personal goals; meets or exceeds personal goals. Monitors and shares information about external events, trends and considers "what ifs" that may affect the ministry.
