It is exciting to see the ministry that is already being done by the local church. One church feeds children in the surrounding colonia three times each week and offers a rehab center for men. That same church hosted 90-100 ladies for a women's conference while we were there.

Another group of churches organized and hosted a retreat for senior citizens. This was a highlight from our time in Cabo. Wayne learned a new term at the retreat — “la tercera edad.” It translates to the third age or stage. The focus was to love and care for those in “la tercera edad.” Attendees spent the weekend relaxing, socializing and recharging their spirits. On the first night, we were able to provide medical consultations, foot care and reading glasses to several of the participants. Dr. Alvaro and Soledad shared the importance of health from a biblical perspective. At one point as he was sharing, Dr. Alvaro said you know what Jeremiah 33:3 says, and to my surprise everyone started quoting the verse by memory. (I had to look it up!)

We are excited to join in the work that God is already doing in Baja through the ministry of Mexican Medical. Not only through the missionaries, but also, and most importantly, the local church. We are blessed to be a blessing.
